

Low carbon growth and the Greater Manchester Strategy

Increased focus on carbon in new Local Transport Plan

Dominant theme in national policy debate and recent Local Transport White Paper

Range of local and national sustainable travel initiatives underway and emerging





Local Sustainable Transport Fund

£560m Government fund for low carbon growth through local transport initiatives Up to £50 million available to Greater Manchester 2011/12 to 2014/15 Greater Manchester bids based on priorities of:

- Kickstarting commuter cycling culture;
- Improving access to work; and
- Maximising the realised potential of current GMTF investment

Good support from a wide community of interests for our bids




Greater Manchester Commuter Cycle Project

DfT confirmed full £4.9 million support for Project

Programme of Cycle Centres and Cycle Compounds by 2015

Supporting package of measures:

- Cycle storage grants
- Cycle training, maintenance and organised rides
- Bike Back to Work
- Cycle promotion and information
- Company cycle assistants





LSTF Major Project Bid

Four core components:

- Sustainable Access to Key Destinations and Transport Hubs
- Supporting Sustainable Choices
- Smarter Travel
- Enabling Community Transport
