
Our Year 2022

We have listened and now it is time to act together to create a comprehensive offer of activities, experiences and opportunities.

Between June and November Children and Young People's voices across Manchester from over **70** different settings were gathered in preparation for Our Year Analysis of consultation has resulted in themes/priorities

Themes

- 'Play' it was recognised the importance of having safe, local and clean spaces for children and young people to play with their friends
- 'Health and Well-being' Young people need and want access to activities and services that promote good mental and physical health
- 'Climate/ Environment'- access to education and opportunities for environmental sustainability. A cleaner, greener city was cited amongst many responses



Themes

- 'Equal and included' The need for activities and services to be inclusive and accessible to all
- 'Feeling Connected' The need to feel connected to family and friends, have a voice and also access to affordable and accessible transport across the city
- 'Safe and Secure' Young people told us that they need and want to feel safe in their communities

In a <u>Child-Friendly City</u>, the voices, needs, priorities and rights of children are an integral part of policies, programmes and decisions. Manchester will be a city where children have opportunities to make friends, get a good start in life, are healthy and cared for, can participate in family, cultural and community life, live in a clean environment with green spaces to play, and have fair life-chances.


